Toolkit for Training Verbal Intelligence

FINISH THE STORY

Description

The activity is done in a group of 10-15 people (the more people, the more fun might be), adding sentences to a story, started by other participants. The sentences have to follow a certain logic. The participants are encouraged to use humour and puns when adding to their peers' ideas.



Time Needed 20 min

There may be various options for the starting sentence

Expected Results

- Training quick and creative thinking
- Training vocabulary, with encouragements to use humour, puns, metaphors...
- Just enjoying the activity and having fun as a group



- Training listening skills
- Training speaking skills
- Training logic
- Training creative thinking and imagination
- Training quick thinking there will be no time to think before answering

Step By Step Guidance

The moderator starts a story with a sentence: **"On that day, she woke up with a deep wish to travel".**

The next participant must add one sentence that is logically connected with the previous one. For example: "So, she started packing her suitcase, when suddenly the phone rang".

Other participants should continue the story, by adding logically connected sentences.

It would be nice if the moderator writes down the story, so that in the end the group could read it together and laugh
